





Task 2: Stitch types

1) Open the picture Monkey.jpg in BasePac




2) Use the Outer Contour tool  to create a fill stitch for the background. Make the stitch direction  horizontal.





4) Use the Outer Contour tool  to create a fill stitch for the ears. Make the stitch direction  vertical.




3) Use the Running tool  for the streamers to create running lines. Set the stitch length to 2 mm.




5) Use for the skin the Outer Contour tool  to create a fill Stitch. Make the stitch direction  vertical.




6) Use Outer Contour tool  for the fur and make a fill stitch. For the ears use Hole and create two holes.




7) Use for the white part in the eye the Outer Contour tool  and make a fill Stitch.





8) Use the Outer Contour tool  to create a fill stitch for the tongue.





9) Use for the two inner ears contour the pairwise tool  to create a satin stitch.




10) Use the Structured tool  for the mouth. Make sure you use Contour cut  on cheeks and tongue.





11) Use the Structured tool  for the face contour. Make sure you use Contour cut  on cheeks and ears.





12) Use for the nose the Pairwise tool  to create a satin stitch.




13) Use for the left eye the Outer Contour tool  to create a fill Stitch. Make the stitch direction  horizontal.




14) Use the Structured tool  for the letters. Make sure you use Contour cut .



15) Use for the right eye the Pairwise tool  to create a satin stitch.



16) Use the Center line tool  for the border.
